The SEASON OF SAIL 2018 SICYC introduces "Vice Commodores", both experienced and inexperienced cruisers alike, to cruise north in company up the NSW and QLD coasts culminating with the annual SICYC Rendezvous in the Gloucester passage on 23 to 26 August.

The concept is that as the fleet moves up the coast other vessels will join increasing the size of the fleet as they go.

COAST GUARD TIN CAN BAY ESCORTED BAR CROSSING 31 MAY.

On arrival at the Wide Bay, the *Tin Can Bay Coast Guard* will provide an escorted crossing of the bar at 0800hrs 31 May...

SUBJECT TO WEATHER CONDITIONS

Coast Guard Tin Can Bay recommend a 0800hrs bar crossing on 31 May.

Boats can either push through from Mooloolaba (about 8hrs) or anchor behind Double Island Point for the evening. Another option is to motor / sail from Tangalooma (about a 12 hrs trip)

TIN CAN BAY WELCOME

After cruising Moreton Bay and Brisbane River areas, the fleet will sail on to Tin Can Bay where on 1 June the next adventure begins!

- Secure anchorage off Snapper Creek, or book a berth in Tin Can Bay Marina.
- A "Meet and Greet" will begin at 4pm at the Tin Can Bay Marina Bar and Grill.
- Wear your SICYC Polos.

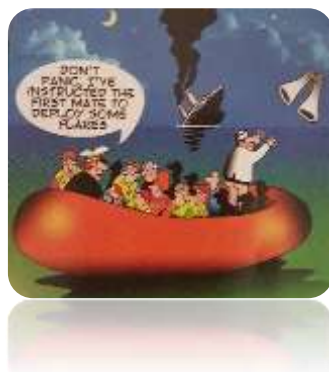

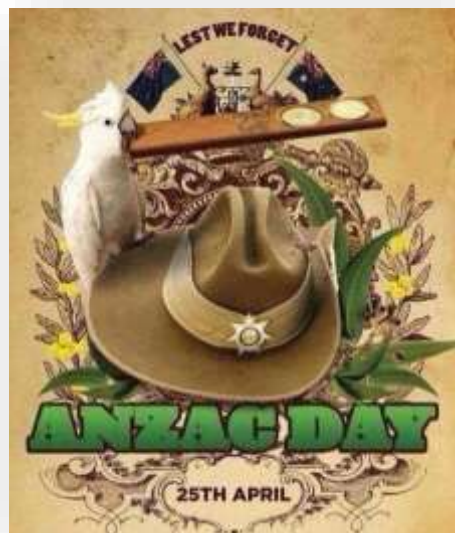
