Shag Islet is an unimposing islet/rock just a few meters off Australia's (20 03.8 S 148 26.5 E) coast a few south of Bowen. Gloucester Island creates a huge barrier to the prevailing south easterly wind so there is of protection. At low tide a long sandy beach emerges and from a distance the SICYC shirts of the reveller. 
