All events cancelled or "on hold" until COVID-19 is over

For the first time ever, SICYC has had to cancel the Season of Sail and the Rendezvous' and other events are postponed until further notice. Below is an extract from the Facebook post regarding this:

"the SICYC Management Committee have made the difficult and devasting decision to postpone all official SICYC events until further notice due to the risks associated with COVID-19 and the related restrictions imposed by the Federal Government and various State Governments. At this stage that includes the Season of Sail and all Rendezvous' and most likely means there will be no official events until at least October this year. If it is at all possible, we will hold the Airlie Beach and Shag Islet Rendezvous' in some form but at this stage that is not certain. We will keep you posted as things progress.

Don't forget to contact fellow Shaggers at anchor on Ch 72, and proudly fly your club burgee as much as possible. We also encourage you to send in photos and videos of your "Shaggers Shenanigans" and tell us where you are and what you are doing. Upload them to our to our Facebook page or send to info@sicyc.com.au to keep the spirit of SICYC alive. It's important we use online technology to keep connected during this time if we can. 
