We will be in a position to advise you of the refinement of the site within a week or so.



## A tenuous grasp on life.

A Story from Keith and Narelle "Vice Commodores" Point Piper and Darling Point

At 7.30am Mark left his western suburbs home for a day of relaxation and fishing. At 8.30am he had arrived at Bobbin Head armed with his kayak and fishing gear and was seen paddling north at a leisurely pace. At 9.10am Mark was knocking hard on deaths door and was very close to being let in.

Also at 9.10am Keith & Narelle were enjoying a leisurely breakfast aboard their boat, *Calm Spirit*, just 50 meters from Mark, when Narelle noticed that the kayak was upside down. Both waited for a minute or so for some splashing or effort to right the kayak, but there was none. Just calm water.

This was very odd, so the breakfast was forgotten and Keith launched the tender and headed for the kayak. What he found was heart stopping. A man of about 60, fortunately floating on his back because of the life jacket he was wearing, but obviously unconscious and his face covered in foam from the mouth. A rope was thrown in the hope that Mark might be able to grasp it but there was no reaction and it was evident that Mark could not help himself get out of the water. What to do?

Not 50 meters away was *Calm Spirit* which is equipped with a hydraulic boarding platform, so after calling out to Narelle to call 000 a rope was secured to Mark's life jacket and he was slowly towed to *Calm Spirit* being careful to keep his feet away from the prop. Narelle lowered the board under water and it was a simple maneuver to get Mark over the board and raised out of the water and lying in the recovery position. Step 1 was achieved.

Next came the call to 000 for the second time to request instructions on how best to help Mark until the professionals arrived. It was a bit frustrating waiting to give the operator all the details of where we were, our names and phone numbers etc, but once past that the help was fantastic.

By the time *Calm Spirit* had motored to Apple Tree Flats and the nearest wharf, the police had arrived, shortly followed by paramedics, two ambulances and water police. They sprang into action stabilizing Mark and preparing him for transportation. A simple lift from the boarding platform and onto the wharf. In no time sirens were blaring and heading for what we thought would be Hornsby Hospital, but instead they went to the Careflight helicopter that had just landed and Mark was transported to Royal North Shore Hospital in an induced coma.

We later heard that Mark had suffered an epileptic seizure, which caused the kayak to capsize and was only minutes away from death, according to the doctors.

<u>Had it not been for the vigilance of Keith & Narelle he would have most certainly drowned on</u> a beautiful, sunny, perfectly calm Saturday morning.

The lesson to all us boaties is, keep vigilant and be prepared for all eventualities.

You never know, it might be you in that kayak.
