



HANDS ACROSS THE BLUE FOR PROSTATE CANCER



Activity Background

"Hands across the blue" is an awareness activity to promote Prostate Cancer Awareness and the work of the Prostate Cancer Foundation of Australia.

Between 11.15am and 11.45am SICYC "Vice Commodores" will raft up in tenders within a prescribed area on the water in the vicinity of Montes Reef Resort .. forming the shape of the Prostate Cancer Logo (wear your SICYC POLO to give the blue Prostate Cancer Logo from the air). Don't forget to bring a drink and possibly some nibblies along.

We will symbolically Hold Hands across the blue for Prostate Cancer Awareness. Dinghies participating will be allocated a participation number (register Thursday or Friday evening at Montes)... a draw will be conducted during the official ceremony and a registered participant will receive a self inflating Dan Buoy donated by SOS Marine





Entertainment and the formal aspects of the activity will be held on MV "Norseman", which will be positioned in close proximity to the raft up on a stern anchor. MV "Norseman" will be equipped with amplification equipment, microphones etc.

Helicopter and water craft will be available to provide media support .. Greg Canning and Luke Mc Caul "Vice Commodores" Dockside and Abell Point Marina will coordinate media.

While we are in the logo position Pop Stanton will provide entertainment ...

During the official part of the program we will be addressed by Doctor Les Thompson on the advancements in Prostate Cancer Research. Entertainment will continue until approx. 1.30pm


