Big Woody Island

Warwick Suttor VC Big Woody 2 "SV Bamboozle

Located 2 Nm off the east coast of Queensland at the northern end of The Great Sandy Straits between Urangan and K'Gari (Fraser Island) lies Big Woody Island. It's land mass 303 hectares, length of 5.5 Nm and a width of 1 Nm at its widest point. Big Woody Island was named by Lieutenant Matthew Flinders in 1799 due to its thick woody growth.

A 25 min boat trip from Urangan Boat Harbour in Hervey Bay. Beaches can be accessed via landing at Jefferies Beach on the South-Eastern coast and One Tree on the southern side

It is sedimentary rock part of the Maryborough formation.

Two good anchorage's I would recommend on Big Woody in northerly winds on the southern side South End deep water close to shore line. Going ashore a bit rocky not good walking. The anchorage is very good holding Approx Lat Lon 25 deg 19s / 152deg 55e. Good fishing.

The other is Jefferies Beach on the northern side of the island. I like the anchorage it

shallows the closer you get to the beach and has a good sandy beach, good fishing in the area, one could tramp to the lighthouse on Middle Bluff about 66mt above sea level, anchorage Lat / Lon 25deg 19s / 152deg 59e good holding anchorage.


